Parents! Come visit us at the Youth Convention on Sunday, February 19th—there's a workshop just for you!

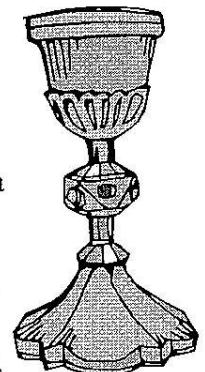
"Surviving and Thriving with our Teenagers" will discuss some practical ideas for communicating with your teen, as well as guidelines for "surviving and thriving" with your children.
