The St. Padre Pio Parish Council was called to order by Laurie Laycock at 6:35 pm. Father Art opened the meeting with a prayer. Linda Giambrone offered to do the opening and closing prayer at the next meeting.

Linda Giambrone made a motion and Jo Ann DeMare seconded to approve the minutes of September with changes. Motion passed.

Old Business: The Vicariate continues to work on hiring a Youth Minister for the area churches.

Reports- Subcommittees

Outreach – The Padre Pio welcome packet has been completed. They will be made available at both sites for parishioners to take starting this weekend. All new parishioners will receive the packet, a church directory, welcome letter, pen and mug.

Church Survey- The survey to help assess the thoughts and needs of parishioners will be given out this weekend. Results will be reviewed to help better serve our members.

Stewardship – The sale of St. Pat's continues. The listing price has been reduced.

Father is reinstating The Building and Grounds Committee which would be a subcommittee of Stewardship. The committee would help review the needs of the churches, get pricing estimates and help formulate ways to complete projects. Current needs include: a new furnace and air conditioning system at OLF, renovation of the St. Cecelia rectory bathroom, new tables, chairs and the extension of the St. Cecelia's parking lot. Anyone interested in serving on the advisory committee should call the office.

Faith Formation – On November 27th the New Roman Missal will be enacted. All changes will be found in the new missals. The sacramental /missal that the priests use for mass were the books purchased by the Altar and Rosary Society. A&R is also paying for the polishing of the sacred vessels. The Praise Masses have been well received. They have been well organized and have helped to orchestrate joyful celebrations of the Eucharist.

Community Building – The new Parish Council members have been elected and will be asked to attend our November meeting. It was suggested we revise our nomination process next year to streamline the process. It was recommended we have Father Art appoint a Youth representative. Laurie Laycock moved and Carole Anderson seconded that we add a youth representative to be appointed by Father Art.

New Business-

Father Art invited everyone to join him at the Ecumenical service on November 20th at Elba's Presbyterian Church. The service starts at 6:00. A short gathering complete with homemade pies and treats will follow.

The Glimmer of Love will be held at the 5:30 mass on December 10th.

A Ministry Fair will be held on November 12th and 13th at the OLF site and November 19th and 20th at the St. Cecelia site. The Fair will highlight the many wonderful ways parishioners can choose to volunteer and help strengthen and contribute to our vibrant parish.

Father Art led us in the "Our Father" and the meeting was adjourned at 8:35. The next meeting will be held on November 28th at 6:30 at the St. Cecelia's site. All parishioners are welcome to attend council meetings.

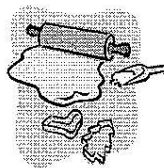

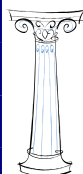
