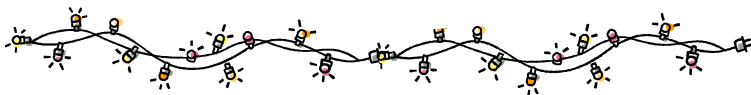

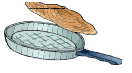
Annual Fatima Trip

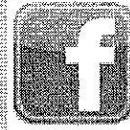

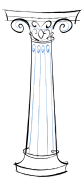
